Dear Mr. Taylor:

A copy of the facilities and administrative (F&A) cost Rate Agreement is being mailed to you for your signature. This agreement reflects an understanding reached between your organization and a member of my staff concerning the rate(s) that may be used to support your claim for F&A and fringe benefit costs on grants and contracts with the Federal Government.

In addition, both parties agree that the differences between the fixed and actual fringe benefit costs for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2011 are:

- Under-recovery of \$94,372 applicable to Faculty and Professional Staff
- Under-recovery of \$142,057 applicable to Non-Academic Staff
- Under-recovery of \$81,508 applicable to Temporary Employees/Students

These amounts are included in your fixed fringe benefit rates for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013 which are listed in the attached Rate Agreement.

Please have the agreement signed by an authorized representative of your organization and send to me, retaining a copy for your files. We will reproduce and distribute the Rate Agreement to the appropriate awarding organizations of the Federal Government for their use.

### SECTION II: SPECIAL REMARKS

### TREATMENT OF FRINGE BENEFITS:

The fringe benefits are charged using the rate(s) listed in the Fringe Benefits Section of this Agreement. The fringe benefits included in the rate(s) are listed below.

# TREATMENT OF PAID ABSENCES

Vacation, holiday, sick leave pay and other paid absences are included in salaries and wages and are claimed on grants, contracts and other agreements as part of the normal cost for salaries and wages. Separate claims are not made for the cost of these paid absences.

OFF-CAMPUS DEFINITION: For all activities performed in facilities not owned by the institution and to which rent is directly allocated to the project(s), the off-campus rate will apply. Actual costs will be apportioned between oncampus and off-campus components. Each portion will bear the appropriate rate.

This organization uses fringe benefits for estimating direct fringe benefit costs on grant applications and contract proposals. The following fringe benefits are covered by the fringe benefits listed in Section I: Worker's Compensation, Unemployment, Accrued Leave payouts at Termination and Severance, Short-Term Disability, and Employee Assistance Program.

For cash claims and final reporting purposes, the following fringe benefits are specifically identified to each employee and charged individually as direct costs: FICA/Medicare, Health Insurance and Retirement.

Equipment means an article of nonexpendable tangible personal property having a useful life of more than one year, and an acquisition cost of \$5,000 or more per unit.

This Rate Agreement updates fringe benefit rates only.

# SECTION III: GENERAL

#### A. <u>LIMITATIONS:</u>

The rates in this Agreement are subject to any statutory or administrative limitations and apply to a given grant, contract or other agreement only to the extent that funds are available. Acceptance of the rates is subject to the pools as finally accepted: such costs incurred by the organization were included in its facilities and administrative cost principles; (2) The same costs are legal obligations of the organization and are allowable under the governing cost costs; (3) Similar types of costs have been accorded consistent accounting treatment; and (4) The information provided by Federal Government. In such situations the rate(s) would be subject to renegotiation at the discretion of the Federal

#### B. ACCOUNTING CHANGES:

This Agreement is based on the accounting system purported by the organization to be in effect during the Agreement period. Changes to the method of accounting for costs which affect the amount of reimbursement resulting from the use of this Agreement require prior approval of the authorized representative of the cognizant agency. Such changes include, but are not limited to, changes in the charging of a particular type of cost from facilities and administrative to direct.

#### C. FIXED RATES:

If a fixed rate is in this Agreement, it is based on an estimate of the costs for the period covered by the rate. When the actual costs for this period are determined, an adjustment will be made to a rate of a future year(s) to compensate for the difference between the costs used to establish the fixed rate and actual costs.

#### D. <u>USE BY OTHER FEDERAL AGENCIES:</u>

The rates in this Agreement were approved in accordance with the authority in Office of Management and Budget Circular A-21 Circular, and should be applied to grants, contracts and other agreements covered by this Circular, subject to any notification of the Agreement.

#### E. OTHER:

If any Federal contract, grant or other agreement is reimbursing facilities and administrative costs by a means other than the approved rate(s) in this Agreement, the organization should (1) credit such costs to the affected programs, and (2) allocable to these programs.
